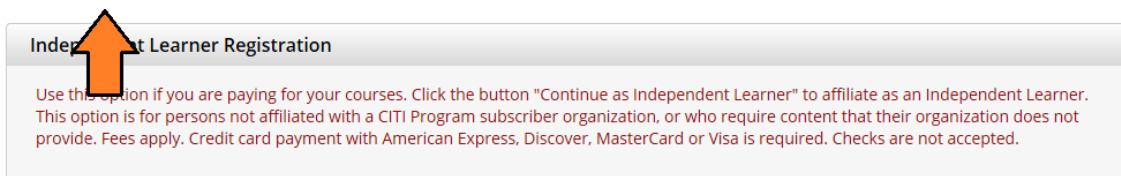
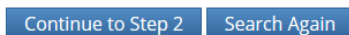
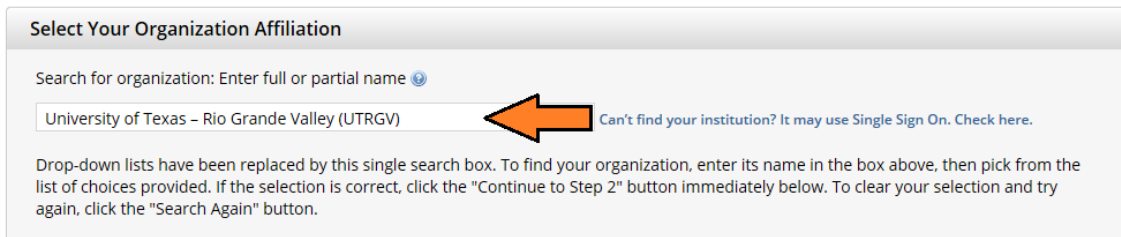
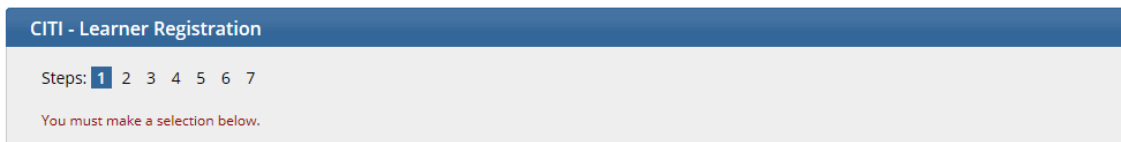
## Instructions for accessing the Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR) Course in CITI:

1. In order to access the RCR mandatory training in CITI, go to [www.citiprogram.org](http://www.citiprogram.org).
2. To create an account, click on “Register”:



3. Complete the Seven Registration Steps:

- Step 1: Select “University of Texas – Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV)” as your institution and click “Continue to Step 2”.



- Step 2: Enter your First Name, Last Name, Email Address, and Verify email address. Then click “Continue to Step 3”.
- Step 3: Create your “User Name”, “Password”, and “Verify Password”. Then choose a “Security Question” and provide a “Security Answer”. Then click “Continue to Step 4”.

**Create your Username and Password**

Your username should consist of 4 to 50 characters. Your username is not case sensitive: "A12B34CD" is the same as "a12b34cd". Once created, your username will be part of the completion report.

- Step 4: Select your “Gender”, “Ethnicity”, and “Race”. Then click on “Continue to Step 5”.
- Step 5: Indicate if interested in “CEU credits” and “Research Surveys”. Then click on “Continue to Step 6”.
- Step 6: Complete the required information (marked with an asterisk). Then click on “Continue to Step 7”.
- Step 7: Select “Responsible Conduct of Research” as the course and click “Next”.

  - Please “Complete the Integrity Assurance Statement before beginning the course”. The system will allow you to start taking the course modules after completing it.
