- Mitigating circumstances which delayed the student's study time and/or prolonged the length of study. Circumstances must be proven through official documentation, such as medical records, insurance documents, letters from officialdom, police records, etc.
- Other academic/personal situation

Important Notice

Appeals based solely on financial and/or emotional needs without sufficient documentation will not be approved. Work is not considered a hardship since financial aid is viewed as a supplement to student income in order to help reduce the number of hours the average student would have to work in any given week. It is the responsibility of the student to successfully complete all classes enrolled. Please remember that dropping a class, failing a class, or withdrawing from a class is a personal decision made by the student. If you do not meet one of the above reasons you are not eligible for an appeal.
