



Vaquero Parking ETIQUETTE

GOOD PARKING MAKES LIFE BETTER!

1. A valid parking permit is required to park on campus at all times.
 2. Parking permits may be used in multiple vehicles owned by the same individual (repositionable).
 3. Pay attention to zones. Each zone parking permit designates where a student, employee, or visitor may park. Your permit indicates what zone you may park within.
 4. Penalties for violations of regulations include parking fines, impoundment of vehicles, and late fees for nonpayment.
 5. Be considerate. Don't park along a red fire lane, in spaces marked solely for people with disabilities, or anywhere else where parking is clearly prohibited.
 6. Make sure to become familiar with our rules and regulations – they're on our website.
- To purchase a permit, including a temporary visitors permit, pay a citation, or appeal a citation; log on to utrgv.edu/myparking.
 - To view campus parking maps, visit utrgv.edu/parking.
 - Can't find parking near your destination? How about using a shuttle bus? Park remotely then take the bus. To view campus shuttle routes, visit us at utrgv.edu/transportation.

WE'RE ALL IN THIS TOGETHER!

1. The Vaquero Express is UTRGV's campus bus system. Bus routes operate both within the Brownsville and Edinburg campuses and between them.
2. Service on any Vaquero Express route is FREE.
3. Catch the bus at a designated location — they are marked with a bus stop sign.
4. Service is based on a first-come, first-served basis. Because all buses have a maximum capacity, get to the bus stop early.
5. We've got partnerships with B Metro in Brownsville and Valley Metro throughout the Rio Grande Valley to provide free trips on their systems with a valid UTRGV ID.
6. If you can't find nearby parking to get to your destination, park in a remote lot and then take the bus. There's no need to walk a long distance.
