Progression Requirements For all dance technique courses, faculty approval is needed to advance from level to level (e.g. from Level I). This may result in repeating a certain level one or more times.

Graduation Requirements Students must earn: a score of Satisfactory or higher in the Professional Portfolio completed in DANC 4302, a grade of "C" or better in all DANC courses, and an overall GPA of 2.5.
