Interview Process	 After a review of the application materials, each candidate is interviewed by at least two program faculty Candidates are asked a series of standardized questions and rated by faculty 	
Admission into the Program	 After all candidate file reviews and interviews are completed, program faculty meet to discuss and vote on each candidate. The successful candidate meets all of the admissions requirements, has relevant background experiences, appropriate letters of recommendation, a coherent statement of purpose, and performs satisfactorily in the faculty interview. 	
Orientation	All candidates who are offered admissions must attend the department New Student Orientation covering the following items: • Program Requirements • Degree Plan • Texas Education Agency Educator Code of Ethics • Distributed Campus Acknowledgment • Registration Procedures
