Internet Access

Internet Access is only available to university students. Guests accounts will need to be requested through IT by guest/department host.

Parking

You may register your vehicle at Parking Services and they will issue you a resident parking permit for the duration of your stay. You must register your vehicle at Parking Services M-F, 8am-5pm at Parking Services located at the ASFC Building behind Unity Hall Building or you can call (956) 665-2738. Parking in other spaces not designated for residents or without a parking permit may result in a parking ticket issued to your vehicle.

House Rules

Any of the following occurrences by you, other registered or non-registered room occupants, or your invitees may result in the immediate termination of your stay.

- No parties or events.
- Be respectful and aware students are living and studying at our facilities
- \bullet Be aware classes are ongoing from 8:00a.m to 10:00 p.m. as well as labs and lectures throughout campus.
- \bullet Feel free to use common areas (game room/TV room) and walk around our campus.
- · Lock doors at all times.
- All personal trash is to be taken to the appropriate designated disposal site and not left in undesignated areas. Trash and left-over food should not be left in the rooms, hallways, or bathrooms.
- Consumption and Storage of Alcohol is prohibited at UTRGV buildings
- Guests shall be liable for any damage, except normal wear and tear to facility. Guest shall keep the room in a good condition and maintain hygiene and cleanliness.

- No smoking.
- Doors should never be propped. This includes room doors, locked doors to hallways, bathroom doors and exterior doors.
- Window screens may not be removed. Throwing things out of windows or using windows for an entry or exit from a room is not permitted.
- Be aware of your noise levels because they may might disrupt students who may be studying in their rooms.
- \bullet We ask all guest to keep noise levels to an appropriate level starting at 10:00 p.m.
- Identification- All guest, including Camp/Conference participants, Camp Counselors, and Tutors, must identify themselves when asked to do so by Housing and Residence Life staff or other University officials.

Lost Keys

Replacement fee of \$50.00 will be charged to the Camp/Conference for every lost key. Once a lock or key change request has been initiated and approved, it cannot be rescinded.
