**Timely Warning Notification**  
**January 3, 2012**

In compliance with the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal **Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998** the University Police Department is giving notice of a Burglary of Habitation report on The University of Texas - Pan American campus.

**Reported Offense: Burglary of Habitation**

The UTPA Police Department has received a report of a Burglary of Habitation occurring at the Bronc Village Apartments of the UTPA campus between 1:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on 01/02/12. The incident was reported to University Police at 10:25 p.m. on 01/02/12. **There were no signs of forced entry in the apartment and a laptop computer was reported stolen.**

**Personal Safety Tips:**

- Create an inventory of your belongings listing the items and serial numbers. Take photos of your valuables. Keep this list and photos in a safe location. This will help assist the police in recovering your items if they are stolen.
