Crime Alert 08/16/12: Indecent Exposure

Campus crime alerts and timely warnings to the community comply with the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (Clery Act).

On Tuesday, August 15, 2012 at approximately 7:10 pm the UTPA Police received a report that a male subject exposed himself while sitting in his vehicle located in parking Lot-B (area of Kuhn St. and North Sugar Road).

The male subject left the area of Lot-B westbound on Kuhn St in a white Chevy sport utility type vehicle.

Suspect Description:

Suspect is described as a Hispanic male, mid to late 20s, light skin complexion, short dark hair on the sides and a bit longer on top, wearing a white shirt and green shorts. The suspect was last seen driving a white Chevy sport utility type vehicle which was described as "very clean". No injuries were reported during the incident.

As a reminder, crime can happen to anyone, anywhere, at anytime through no fault of the victim. Students, faculty, staff, and the UTPA community can utilize personal safety precautions.

- **Always be aware of your surroundings.**
- **Trust your instincts. If you suspect something is wrong, try to remove yourself from the situation.**
- **Notify local law enforcement of the suspicious activity as soon as possible.**
- **There is safety in numbers. Walk with friends or family.**
- **Avoid isolated or poorly lighted areas.**
