## <u>Timely Warning Notification – June 25, 2015:</u>

In compliance with the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998, the University Police Department is giving notice of two (2) Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle (golf carts) reports on the UTPA Campus.

### Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle (golf carts):

The UTPA Police Department has received (2) reports of Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle (golf carts). The first incident occurred between 06/21/15 at around 6:30 p.m. to 06/23/15 at around 6:45 a.m. This golf cart was taken from the north side of the cafeteria. The golf cart was described as Beige in color, 2003 Club Car with a black box in the back. The front seat was described as beige and the rear seat was dark brown.

The second incident occurred today, 06/25/15 at around 2:13 p.m. This golf cart was taken from the south east side of the Academic Services Building. This golf cart is described as a Gray Club Car with an aluminum bed.

### Suspect(s) Information:

After reviewing surveillance footage from the incident today it was learned that two (2) Hispanic males (dark complexion) were seeing driving off in the golf cart from the south east side of the Academic Services Building. The golf cart traveled along the north side of parking Lot-G; crossed N. 5<sup>th</sup> to parking Lot-I. Last direction of travel was north bound on 5<sup>th</sup> Street passing Schunior Street.

*Suspect 1* Hispanic male wearing a black T-shirt with dark shorts with a white thick vertical stripe along both sides. He was wearing Gray tennis shoes.

*Suspect 2* Hispanic male wearing a black T-shirt with light blue shorts with a dark blue thick vertical stripe along both sides.

### **Theft Prevention Tips:**

- Don't leave golf carts unattended in open areas for an extended period of time
- Install locking devices for batteries, wheels, etc.
- Install fuel cutoff switches on gas operated golf carts
- Install a second ignition switch or "kill switch"
