### Timely Warning Notification - December 16th, 2015:

In compliance with the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998, the University Police Department is giving notice of a Burglary of a Building report on the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (Brownsville Campus).

### **Burglary of a Building:**

On December 15th, 2015 at approximately 8:45 p.m. the UTRGV Police Department received a report of three (3) suspicious male juveniles on the

Texas Southmost College side of Ringgold Road carrying a television set. URTGV police officers responded to the area of the Calvary building and recovered a television set belonging to the UTRGV Astronomy Department. The area was searched for suspects but none were located. The investigation has determined that the burglary occurred between the hours of 5:30 p.m. and 8:45 p.m.

## Suspect(s) Information:

The suspects are believed to be three (3) male juveniles. No other information is available at this time.

#### Safety Tips:

- Always lock your doors whenever you leave your office or apartment, even if you will only be gone for a short time.
- Make sure your windows are locked. Close any shades at night so no one can see in your room or office – always lock your doors.
- Do not leave valuables in plain sight. When you will be out, place any valuables in drawers or your closet always lock your doors.
- Report suspicious people to the UTRGV Police immediately.
- In the event you discover a burglary, leave the area immediately and call the UTRGV Police Department.
- Create an inventory of your belongings, listing the items and serial numbers.
- Take photos of your valuables, and keep this list and photos in a safe location.
