UTRGV's Fall 2016 Enrollment in Perspective

Data from THECB's online accountability system at <u>http://www.txhigheredaccountability.org/acctpublic/</u> was used to look at UTRGV's total enrollment and Hispanic enrollment as compared to other 4-yr public universities in Texas and within the UT System.

- UTRGV's enrollment of 27,504 students in Fall 2016 makes it the 9th largest 4-year public university in Texas and 4th largest within the UT System (see Tables 1 and 2 below).
- UTRGV has the highest Hispanic enrollment (24,520 students) among all 4-yr public universities in Texas (see Table 3 on next page).
