Purpose

Upward Bound is a college preparatory program funded by the U.S. Department of Education. The program is designed to generate the knowledge, skills, and motivation necessary for success in postsecondary school.

Eligible Participants

Participants must be students from the Brownsville Independent School District high schools – Lopez, Porter, Rivera – who are in the 9th, 10th, or 11th grade and who meet federal eligibility requirements. Seniors are not eligible.

Federal Requirements

- Two-thirds of the UTRGV Upward Bound participants must meet income criteria and must be first-generation college students.
- One-third of the students may be either low-income or a first-generation college student. First-generation college students are those who have had neither parent complete a bachelor's degree. All participants must be citizens of the United States or permanent resident aliens.
- All students must have the potential for success in postsecondary school, but must be in need of academic support and/ or assistance to assure entrance into and success in college.
- All applicants must have a marked interest in pursuing a postsecondary education.

Academic Year

During the school year, the program provides academic services to students on a weekly basis. Enrichment classes are held up to two Saturdays each month, offering special work in mathematics, reading, grammar, computer science, college research, and career research. The program also offers tutoring, Monday through Thursday, during lunch, in-class and/ or after school. Counseling services are provided in the areas of academics, financial assistance, and college/career exploration.

Participants who are seniors in high school are assisted with the college admissions process. This process includes the completion of applications for admission, college entry exams and financial aid.

Each student's academic abilities are evaluated annually, and an educational college preparation plan is reviewed in order to align program services with the participant's academic goals.

Summer Program

During the summer, students must participate in a six-week, nonresidential program. Students attend college-simulated classes or college credit courses, and other enrichment classes, on campus Monday through Friday.

The summer program assists students in obtaining the skills and motivation necessary to succeed in postsecondary school. Students are taught, whenever possible, by college faculty and personnel. Students attend lectures and classes designed to meet the goals of the program.

Cost

There is no cost to the student. Students may also receive a stipend for active regular participation.

Application Information

New participants are recruited through the middle and high school counseling offices, classroom presentations, and by recommendations. Students may obtain applications from their school counselors or by contacting the UTRGV Upward Bound Office at their respective high school campus.

Completed applications must be returned by announced deadlines. Applicants must also complete a parent/student interview to be considered for acceptance into the program.

No student is denied admission to Upward Bound because of religion, race, national origin, gender, or physical handicap.

Acceptance into this program is competitive, based on participant vacancies, and a minimum score obtained in the following criteria:

- 1. Income/Parent Education Status
- 2. Transcripts/Academic Need
- 3. Counselor and Teacher Recommendations
- 4. Student Interview
- 5. Parental Interview
- 6. Application/Documentation

Application Checklist:

- A completed application must be returned to either your high school counselor or to the UTRGV Upward Bound
 Office. Electronic applications are also available.
- It is the responsibility of the student to assure completion of the application, including the letters of recommendation (two from core curriculum teachers and one from a counselor). Check with the teachers to whom you gave recommendation forms.

A completed application consists of these items:

- Application form with all applicable questions answered completely.
- Proof of citizenship or legal citizenship status.
- Income verification.
 - A copy of parent/guardian's latest income tax Form 1040 if filed, or
 - Income verification form for those who do not file an income tax return is included in the application. It must be notarized/signed.
- Official high school transcript or 8th grade transcript for prospective 9th grade applicants.
- Available test scores and may include any of the following: PSAT, ACT and other state mandated exams.
- Three recommendations.
 - One counselor
 - Two teachers (core subject courses required).

Note:

Make sure you and your parent or guardian sign as directed. Acceptance into Upward Bound is highly competetive. Do not miss this opportunity by not completing the application.
