

The Multidisciplinary Studies degree program allows students to custom design a plan of study that brings together course work from three disciplines rather than the two disciplines reflected by the traditional academic major/minor format.

A – GENERAL EDUCATION CORE – 42 HOURS

Students must fulfill the General Education Core requirements.

B – MAJOR REQUIREMENTS – 54 HOURS (36 advanced)

Choose three approved minors of at least 18 hours each. Each minor must include 12 advanced hours.

C – FREE ELECTIVES – 24 HOURS (6 advanced)
