The Psychiatric-Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (PMHNP) Post-Master's certificate program prepares nurses to provide effective care for patients with complex psychiatric and physical health needs. PMHNPs work with individuals and families to develop a diagnosis and then design, implement and monitor a plan of care. Responsibilities can also include prescribing medication and administering psychotherapy.

The coursework and practicum was designed to assist students in acquiring the advanced knowledge and clinical skills needed to care for clients across the lifespan. The foundation for advanced practice is focused on content included in advanced courses in pathophysiology, pharmacotherapeutics and health assessment.

Prospective students are advised to confirm whether the board of nursing in their home state has approved the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley as a nursing education program prior to applying to the program.

ADMISSION CRITERIA:

To be admitted to the psychiatric mental health nurse practitioner graduate certificate, prospective candidates must first meet all requirements for graduate admission to UT Rio Grande Valley, as well as the other requirements listed below:

1. Master of Science in Nursing: Active Licensed Nurse Practitioner (NP) with at least one year psychiatric/mental health nursing specialty practice
OR
Master of Science in Nursing: with **successful** completion **within 3 years** of three separate courses in graduate/ **advanced** level including Advanced Physical Assessment (equivalent to UTRGV SON NURS 6305.90L), Advanced Pharmacotherapeutics (equivalent to UTRGV SON NURS 6306.90L), and Advanced Pathophysiology (equivalent to UTRGV SON NURS 6304.90L) with at least 3 years of psychiatric/mental health specialty nursing practice.
FROM a Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) or Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) accredited program in nursing.
2. A “live/face to face” or “virtual” interview with PMHNP Program Admission Committee.
3. A Current Resume/Curriculum Vitae.
4. GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
5. Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended.
6. A current unencumbered license to practice as a Registered Nurse (RN) in your state of residence.
7. Cleared Criminal Background Check.
8. Evidence of current immunizations required by the Texas Department of Health for student in health-related academic programs.
