

## Construction Management Certificate - Online Program

### Overview

The Construction Management certificate is a post-bachelor's degree program for professionals in the construction industry. The purpose of the Construction Management certificate is to provide students with specialized skills required to excel in managing complex construction projects. Construction Management is essential to ensure project success and minimize the risks of time delays, cost overruns, and disputes. The certificate covers essential knowledge that will prepare students for various roles, such as project managers, project engineers, planners, cost estimators, and others. Construction Management knowledge is needed for a variety of roles as contractors, architects, designers, engineers, suppliers, owners, and developers.

### Admission Requirements

To be admitted to the Construction Management Certificate program with clear admission status, prospective candidates must first meet all requirements for graduate admission to UT Rio Grande Valley, as well as the other requirements listed below:

1. Bachelor's degree in civil engineering, construction engineering and management, or architecture.
2. Undergraduate GPA of at least 3.0 in the last 60 semester credit hours.
