

SAFETY PLAN - SEIZURES

Student: If *you* experience a seizure while on campus, please contact Student Accessibility Services (SAS) to inform us at 882-7374 or 665-7005.

University staff and faculty: You are required to follow the general procedures below.

Life-Threatening Conditions

1. Check the scene for safety. Check the victim for consciousness, breathing, pulse, and severe bleeding.

2. *If the victim...*

- Is unconscious.
- Has trouble breathing or is breathing in a strange way.
- Has chest pain or pressure.
- Is bleeding severely.
- Has pressure or pain in the abdomen that does not go away.
- Is vomiting or passing blood.
- Has repeated seizures or a seizure that lasts for more than a few minutes.
- Has a severe headache or slurred speech.
- Appears to have been poisoned.
- Has injuries to the head, neck, or back.
- Has possible broken bones.

...Immediately call 911 and then UTRGV Police (when time allows)
