## ADMISSION, PROGRESSION, AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:

Students will be required to have an overall 2.75 minimum GPA tollowing second semester of Undergraduate course work and a minimum grade of B in Anatomy & Physiology I/Lab, Anatomy & Physiology II/Lab in order to transfer to the Exercise Science major. It admitted to the Exercise Science major, students are required to maintain a 2.75 GPA in their Core courses to remain in the program. Students who do not maintain this GPA will be placed on academic probation for one semester. If they do not meet the criteria after one semester, they will be dismissed from the

A grade of 'C' or better must be maintained in all advanced coursework.
