Admission Requirements

Students must pass an audition prior to beginning the music program. For teacher certification, students must apply for admission and be accepted to the College of Education and P-16 Integration prior to enrolling in teacher certification courses, except for MUSI 4313 which is open to all students. A grade of 'C' or better is required in all music courses. This includes MUSI, MUAP, and MUEN coursework.
