Spanish Translation & Interpreting students need to complete the Spanish placement exam to determine the first Spanish course in their BA. According to the results, they will follow one of the three tracks below:

Students placed in SPAN 2313 will follow TRACK 1 (orange). They will complete all the courses in white + those labeled as "TRACK 1" (highlighted in orange).

Students placed in SPAN 2315 will follow TRACK 2 (yellow). They will complete all the courses in white + those labeled as "TRACK 2" (highlighted in yellow).

Students placed in SPAN 3313 will follow TRACK 3 (blue). They will complete all the courses in white + those labeled as "TRACK 3" (highlighted in blue).
