ADMISSION, PROGRESSION, AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS, if applicable: For admission, students must complete of 57 hours of course work, have Junior standing, and be admitted to the Teacher Education program.

Progression requirements: A grade of 'C' or better must be maintained in all advanced coursework. For teacher certification, students must apply for admission and be accepted to the College of Education and P-16 Integration prior to enrolling in teacher certification courses, except for EDFR 2301 which is open to all students

Graduation requirements 1. A GPA of 2.75 or greater in each section is required for graduation.
