In addition to the education courses listed in the table, EC-6 ESL students must complete their major area coursework.

- **Education major area courses** (must be taken before student teaching): READ 3320, READ 3324
- **Major area courses outside of the College of Education** (take any semester before graduation): ENGL 4360, ENGL 4375 (may be replaced with EDSL 3320) + all major area courses on degree plan

Certification Exams: In addition to your coursework you will need to complete certain state certification exams in order to be admitted into clinical teaching. Check with your department chair or program coordinator for information related to certification exams.
