- **Education major area courses** (must be taken before student teaching): READ 3320, READ 3350
- **Major area courses outside of the College of Education** (take any semester before graduation): ENGL 4360, ENGL 4375 (if not replaced with EDSL 3320) + all major area courses on degree plan
