

Student Experience Internship Program (SEI) Student Criteria, Eligibility, and Expectations



What Students Will Gain

The **Student Experience Internship (SEI) program** is a paid internship program that will provide students the opportunity to develop professional and technical skills through hands-on learning to further support their career development. The SEI program is a specialized student employment program with focus on industry and field specific work relevant to the student's field of study.

Academic Credit: Students will have the opportunity to receive academic credit for their participation in the SEI program. While academic credit is encouraged, it is not required. Students seeking to receive academic credit for their internship should contact their academic department for course requirements and/or prerequisites.

Program Eligibility

Candidates must:

- Be pursuing a bachelor's degree for the first time at UTRGV
- Be enrolled 15 credit hours or more, each fall and spring semesters
- Be enrolled 6 credit hours during summer sessions (to continue working in the summer if funding is available)
- · Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher with good academic standing
- Meet SAP (Satisfactory Academic Progress) requirements
- A minimum of 12 credit hours completed in residence as a full-time student at UTRGV
- A minimum of 30 credit hours completed for transfer students
- A maximum of 100 credit hours completed for first time applicants
- Be a U.S. Citizen, Permanent Resident, or International Student with F-1 Visa.

Disqualifications:

High School graduate or GED (High school students do not qualify)

Student Employment eligibility ends on the day a student separates from UTRGV for any reason other than completing his/her coursework





Professional Achievement Experiences with SEI

Students participating in the **Student Experience Internship (SEI) program** will immerse themselves into experiences that will allow them to develop leadership skills, adopt professionalism, and excel in their career development. SEI students can expect to be involved in the following programs and activities.

- · Participate in a one-time presentation showcasing your SEI experience
