USING VIDEO-CUED ETHNOGRAPHY TO CENTER LATINE IMMIGRANT PARENTS' KNOWLEDGE OF BILINGUAL/BICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT

CBS hosted an insightful session inviting the UTRGV community to explore the experiences of Latine immigrant parents in the U.S. Mexican Borderlands. The discussion focused on bilingual and bicultural development, highlighting the challenges and strengths of raising children in a cross-cultural environment. Speakers shared how parents value their children's bilingual potential, and attendees engaged in thoughtful conversations through questions and discussion.



CONECTAR IDIOMAS, CONSTRUIR ÉXITOS: MAXIMIZAR EL PODER DE LAS PRÁCTICAS DE LA HERENCIA BILINGÜE

As part of our ongoing commitment to support the youth in our Rio Grande Valley community, CBS staff had the privilege of visiting PSJA Carmen Anaya Elementary and McAllen ISD Blanca E Sanchez Elementary schools. During this outreach event, staff and student assistants had the opportunity to engage with a group of enthusiastic fourth and fifth grade students. An inspiring message was shared about perseverance and the importance of higher education.

Our presentation focused on encouraging students to be resilient, emphasizing that their backgrounds, whether coming from Spanish-speaking communities or any other experience, should never limit their aspirations. The importance of education as a pathway to brighter futures and how every student has the potential to achieve greatness, no matter where they start, was the theme of engagement.

This event was focused on providing valuable information to parents about available resources that can support the academic and personal success of their children.

The symposium featured a variety of community speakers, informational tables, and interactive spaces where attendees had the opportunity to ask questions and receive direct guidance. During our participation, CBS shared educational resources, promoted the importance of bilingualism at home, and reaffirmed its commitment to strengthening the connections between the community and educational institutions.

ANNUAL TORNEO DE ORTOGRAFÍA & BATALLA DE LOS LIBROS



The Center for Bilingual Studies (CBS) at the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) hosted the 2025 Torneo de Ortografía del Valle del Rio Grande on Saturday, April 5, 2025, from 8 AM- 12:00 PM and our inaugural Batalla de los Libros event from 1:00 PM - 4:00 PM at UTRGV's College of Education & P16 Integration on the Edinburg campus.

The Torneo de Ortografía del Valle del Rio Grande is an annual competition in which 2nd-12th grade students from across the Rio Grande Valley and undergraduates from UTRGV demonstrate their Spanish spelling skills. The tournament aims to help bilingual students feel proud of their language and culture and promote their use of Spanish in an academic context. Our goal for this year is to continue the tradition and also increase our number of participants, so we have invited students from 37 school districts from Laredo to Brownsville.

We welcomed roughly about 250 students that participated in the event this year. Each student earned a medal for participation, and the top five winners from each category (Primaria, Intermedia, Secundaria, Preparatoria y Universitaria) earned a trophy.

Additionally, we recognized the first-place winners of each category with a *Copa Rotante* housed at their campus. This year, we invited three school districts for our inaugural Batalla de los Libros event, in which students from 4th-5th grade are required to study three Spanish novels highlighting the Latino experience in the U.S. and use their reading skills to compete for the grand prize.
