Complete the preparation assigned in EDUC 3302.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Complete Certify Teacher for the PPR and achieve a score of 80% or higher in all four domains by the 1st Friday of March (Spring) / 2nd Friday of October (Fall).</li> </ul> <p>2. This exam must be taken when enrolled in EDUC 3304 and/or EDUC 3306.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>When 80% or higher is achieved, proceed to Step 2 of Teacher Certification Roadmap by submitting a <u>TEGES Testing Request Application</u> in Tk20 with your Certify Teacher score report uploaded.</li> </ul> <p>3. Take your official Certification exam by the 3rd Friday of June (Spring) / 3rd Friday of November (Fall).</p> <p>If you did not pass, please refer to 2<sup>nd</sup> Attempt process within 48 hours of receiving your official score report.</p>	<p>1. Create an <u>Eligibility Request Form</u> on Tk20 within 48 hours of receiving your official Pearson score report and upload it to the application.</p> <p>2. Take the STR (293) Representative Exam by the 3rd Friday of March (Spring) / 2nd Friday of November (Fall).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The link to register can be found at the bottom of the OEPA homepage.</li> </ul> <p>3. Create an <u>Eligibility Request Form</u> application on Tk20 with your Item Analysis Sheet (Representative Exam results) uploaded within 48 hours of test-taking.</p> <p>4. The Certification Exam Support Hub will issue an individualized study prescription on Tk20.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Complete the study plan within the time frame given in your prescription.</li> <li>For Domain 013, attend a workshop to obtain clearance.</li> <li>Tutoring sessions are mandatory as indicated in your study prescription.</li> </ul> <p>5. Email completed study plan and score report/transcript (ex.
