Application Requirements: The application packet should be a single PDF file and include the following:

- 1. A description of the applicant's research interest. Water interest preferred. (*1 paragraph, approximately 100 words*)
- 2. A brief one page paper on your knowledge of the Arroyo Colorado Watershed, the Lower Laguna Madre Watershed, and Texas Estuary programs.
- 3. A brief one page paper on your knowledge of the Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Program. In particular the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) permit.
- 4. A brief one page paper on your knowledge of Low Impact Development and Green Infrastructure.
- 5. Applicant's curriculum vitae/resumé. (Up to two pages)
- 6. **Transcript** providing evidence of applicant's cumulative GPA. (*"unofficial" transcripts are acceptable*)
- 7. Applicant's expected BS graduation date and career plans. (Up to 100 words)
- 8. Applicants preferred: sophomore or junior in good standing. Seniors may apply.
