

Upon entering the Ph.D. Program in Clinical Psychology, *all students will be assigned a mentor*. The mentor will be a member of the program department.

Academic mentoring includes the following elements that are designed to ensure that students remain in good academic standing and make satisfactory progress through the program.

## **EVALUATION**



- Ensuring that annual/end of the semester reviews between student and mentor and/or supervising committee occur.
- The results of this review will be included in the program's annual doctoral progress report.



- Reviewing the student's Degree Plan to determine if the student is making progress consistent with the expectations of the program and reaching milestones according to the timeline provided on this form
  - Working with the Doctoral Studies Committee and student to determine if modifications are necessary
  - Clarifying the timetable for completing any remaining course requirements, examinations, and other requirements
