Theoretical and practical implications are discussed.

A smart healthcare system is a case where a person uses technology (e.g., biomedical devices and sensors) to self-monitoring his/her biological, physical, or behavioral aspects. One of the main objectives of such a system is to move the current healthcare systems from being reactive illness-driven to a proactive wellness-driven healthcare system (Arulananthan and Hanifa, 2017). However, the ultimate success of a personalized smart healthcare system depends on the level of acceptance by the individuals. This study will propose a theoretical framework, which is based on the expectancy-valence theory that helps to understand the motivational factors that influence individual's usage of smart healthcare systems. The proposed model includes expectancy, instrumentality, and valence factors. The research model will also examine the moderating role of some factors such as self-efficacy, social influence, and trust in the smart healthcare system, and trust in its providers. To measure these factors, latent constructs will be indirectly measured through the items listed in the survey questionnaire.
