

Instrument Locker Policy 2025 - 2026

Instrument lockers are available <u>only</u> to UTRGV music majors and minors. By accepting a locker assignment, students agree to comply with the following:

- Lockers and locks are assigned to each student by the School of Music Office (EPACB B2.108 in Edinburg and BMSLC 2.214 in Brownsville)
- Lockers are intended to help store and protect primary instruments and are assigned based on instrument size and proportion. Piano and voice students can be assigned convenience lockers which are only appropriate for sheet music, personal items, etc. (Marching Band members must contact Dr. Ferguson regarding instrument storage.)
- Lockers are <u>only</u> to store instruments and any sheet music or personal belongings. All perishable and open or repackaged nonperishable food and beverages are <u>NOT allowed</u> to be stored in the lockers.
- Students may be assigned additional lockers for secondary instruments and ensemble instruments *when space is available*.
- Lockers are assigned for the academic year. Students will be required to clear their lockers during the last week of the <u>spring semester</u>. The deadline for locker clearance will be announced <u>prior to the last week of the spring semester</u>. Any items left in lockers after the final deadline will be discarded or turned over to the UTRGV Police Department.
- UTRGV School of Music is not responsible for loss, theft, and or damage to any locker contents.
- Lockers will not be decorated. Use of adhesives, gels, etchings, or other markings will be considered vandalism. Students will be charged for cleaning and repair of any damage caused.
- Students understand that violation of these conditions may result in loss of locker privileges, in addition to any appropriate legal action.
