- 1. Have research in line with the priorities of the college
- 2. Need support to complete an existing research project
- 3. Have identified specific external funding opportunities to continue the research
- 4. Have identified collaborative partners within the college
- 5. Have matching funds from their school/department
- 6. Need support to disseminate their findings

Application deadline for awards is every month on the 15th. Notification Important dates

- Proposals due: February 15, 2018 and every subsequent month on the 15th
- Notifications by: March 1, 2018 and every subsequent month on the first working day.

Submission Guidelines

Please include the following information in your proposal submission in a single PDF file:

- Proposal title
- Names of all authors and affiliations
- Lead researcher contact information (address, phone, email)
- short bios detailing credentials and experience of each researcher (4-5 sentences)
- statement of alignment with COHA mission statement
- Statement on what support is needed: This must be consistent with the supporting documentation
- Budget
- Supporting documentation. Please select which are applicable to your request:
 - o Submitted grant application and referee comments
 - o Submitted publication and reviewer comments
 - Draft Grant application

- please identify where additional data is needed to make this grant application competitive
- Draft Research publication:
 - Please identify the weakness of the manuscript for which you are seeking funding
