## Pure Mathematics Seminar

Symbolic substitutions as automorphisms of the free group

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One-dimensional aperiodic sequences can be generated by substitutions like the Fibonacci substitution  $a \to ab, b \to a$ . Such a substitution can be viewed as an endomorphism of the free group over two letters. If this endomorphism happens to be invertible this leads to a convenient notion of the dual substitution. Two natural questions are (1.) which substitutions are self-dual, (2.) which compositions of different substitutions are equal? This talk answers both questions.
