

Description

(3.1) Students will be able to successfully design and personally justify a research project by successfully writing a research proposal in COMM 6300 Communication Research. Successful completion requires a minimum grade of "B" in course and a minimum Module score of 80%.

(3.2) Students will be able to successfully execute a research project by successfully collecting, analyzing, and interpreting research results in COMM 6328 Applied Communication Research. Successful completion requires a minimum grade of "B" in course and a score of 80%.

(3.3) Students will be able to successfully justify research project by orally presenting the personally-authored research project to the student body of the university. Successful completion requires a minimum grade of "B" in presentation and a minimum Module score of 80%.
