- Opportunity to transit to the UTRGV Ph.D. program in Mathematics and Statistics with Interdisciplinary Applications (MSIA) in which computational mathematics with ECE is one of concentrations after MSE graduation

1. Applied and are accepted in the full-time study for M.S.E in Electrical Engineering at UTRGV

3. Have demonstrable financial need based on information on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
4. Are United States citizens, nationals, permanent residents, or can provide evidence from the Immigration and Naturalization Service that they are in the process of becoming permanent residents of United States.
