DRIVER SAFETY ONLINE TRAINING INSTRUCTIONS

The department of Environmental Health, Safety and Risk Management provides **Driver Safety Training** online through UT System's Learning Management System (LMS)- Safety Skills: Work Smarter.

Instructions to complete the UTRGV Driver Safety Training:

- 1. Email <u>EHSRM@utrgv.edu</u> to request Driver Safety Training and include date needed by.
- 2. You will be notified via email once you are set up in the UT System LMS and will receive additional emails for each training assignment also from UT System.
- 3. Log on to UT System's LMS with your UTRGV email and password: LMS Sign In (inclassnow.com)
- 4. You may be prompted to reset your password if this is your first time accessing the LMS.
- 5. Click on the My Trainings tab.
- 6. Complete the 5 driver safety training modules listed under Current Training.
 - a. The University of Texas System Driver Safety training Online Course: Unit 1. University of Texas System Policies
 - b. The University of Texas System Driver Safety training Online Course: Unit 2. Human Factors
 - c. The University of Texas System Driver Safety training Online Course: Unit 3. Vehicle and Equipment Factors
 - d. The University of Texas System Driver Safety training Online Course: Unit 4. Environmental Factors
 - e. The University of Texas System Driver Safety training Online Course: Unit 5. Assessment
- 7. A certificate will be generated for you within the LMS for each completed module.
- 8. Complete Motor Vehicle Record form and submit to EHSRM@utrgv.edu
- 9. EHSRM will notify you of your driver authorization status once the training and MVR check has been completed.
