Marilyn Hagerty asked about requiring CSCI 1380 in the 090-core area and not putting in the support classes since students are also using the science labs in this area. Dr. Saenz added that the labs for the sciences can be used in the free electives area of the program. Marilyn also asked that since CYBI 2322 is not a prerequisite for CYBI 2324

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and CYBI 2326 that they can be taken in any order. Dr. Khan recommends that all three courses are taken together in the Fall semester.

Rosie Pena asked about the new courses and if they are cross listed with any CSCI courses or any other in the College of Engineering. Dr. Khan stated that only CSCI 3335 is cross listed with CSCI 4345, which the course form has it listed in the Active Equivalent box. Rosie also asked about students on the current degree plan and those who will be on the new degree, making sure the current students are still able to complete the new courses. Dr. Saenz created a crosswalk to show all courses changes and stated that students may want to move to the new degree plan.

Dr. Saenz recommended that the Cyber Security for Majors minor be removed from the Change of Major portal effective immediately. Sofia Almeda agreed.

Dr. Shupala stated that it will be submitted to the UT System and then they will submit to the Higher Education Coordinating Board. Due to the program only having one new course and a repackaging of existing coursework to create a new degree, there is now an expedited process through the UT System. The full proposal does not need to be completed and because no new resources are required a budget is not needed. This new process will expedite the review and approval on new program like this one.
