 - BIOL 4201 is incorrectly listed under "Revise Course" this course is actually being deleted
 - BS in Biology (Biological Sciences) degree track students are steered toward this degree plan if they are on a pre-professional track – very science heavy – no minor required – minimal effects from these changes as required courses for degree are still offered
 - BS in Biology w/ Minor Option minimal effects required courses for degree still offered with a lot of elective options for minor
 - Most impact of program revisions will be on degrees with teacher certification. Removing BIOL 4400 from both degree plans because there is a lot of overlap between that course and a course in UTEACH program (BIOL 4392). 4392 currently only offered in Edinburg – working on getting faculty in Brownsville to be able to teach the course.

- Blanket Waiver: 1
 - Notes:
 - Revisions to update prerequisites, number of times a course can be repeated, hidden prerequisites
 - Courses deleted are lecture and their associated labs that were developed and offered as remedial courses for students prior to taking their required CHEM courses. These courses never worked as there was no credit associated with them. CHEM 3307 and 4401 are no longer being taught.
 - Programs are being revised as a result of clean-up of hidden prerequisites. 6 hours had to be eliminated from the degree to accomodate the addition of these prerequisites.
 - Blanket Substitution for CHEM 3201 which was replaced by CHEM 3101 to more accurately reflect the hours that the course meets per week.
 - Waiver for CHEM 4101 which has been deleted from the program. The content is replaced by a new capstone (CHEM 4305). Concerns were raised by Peter-James Ehimika from the Office of Student Academic Success as to how this will be addressed with students who have already received credit for 4101 AND have also taken CHEM 3101 (fewer credit hours than the previous option). Those students would end up short on credit hours for graduation. Mr. Ehimika would like there to be documented protections for the students that are impacted by this change. Dr. Ahmad states that this is a very small number of students and can be dealt with on



an individual basis without a need for a blanket waiver for this particular issue. Dr. Ahmad is committing on record that the Chemistry Department will make the necessary accommodation for these affected students.

 - Clarification was provided that the degree programs contain a graduation requirement of a "C" or better for all MATH courses.
