- i) Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders PRESENTER: Teri Mata-Pistokache
 - (1) Update on the Leveling Curriculum

Dr. Saenz updated the status of the proposed Leveling Certificate. It is common practice for the department to have the students complete the Leveling Curriculum but is not awarded as a Certificate. Teri informed the committee that the Leveling Curriculum was for students who do not have a degree in Communications Disorder to be able to practice as a Speech Therapist or a Speech Pathologist. The State of Texas requires a license awarded by the State Board to practice. This curriculum will allow student to take leveling courses and apply to take the license to practice. The plan is also to create a website and handbook for students.
