Revised Standing Committee overview

- Senators are expected to serve on one FS Standing Committee
- 73 Senators / 7 committees = ~10 (6-14) members per committee
- Larger committees

 - 2. Faculty Rules and Governance Committee
 - 3. Research Policy Committee
 - 4. Faculty grievance support/conflict resolution group
 - Minor time commitment, open to non-Senators
 - Doesn't count as required Standing Committee

Council on Academic Freedom and Responsibility

- SB 18 restricting tenure
- SB 17 outlawing DEI
 - Shared with Education Policy Committee
- Forthcoming legislative changes impacting higher ed
 - Abbott charged TX legislature
- 1st amendment issues and challenges

Education Policy Committee

- Share effort related to SB17, especially with how it impacts available coursework, degree programs, student research and training opportunities, and student success broadly.
- Micro-credentialing
- Liaise with Technology-Enhanced Education Oversight Committee and others related to AI use by students, for teaching, in classrooms, etc.

Faculty Welfare Committee

- Wellness broadly (including burnout)
- New charge and focal area: Family Affairs
- Sarah has shared a survey instrument we can use for general/academic faculty burnout

Faculty Rules and Governance Committee

- Revise constitution, especially related to voting
- Lead/help development of policy priorities
 - Workload
 - Grievance
 - Dept reorganization
 - Financial exigency

Research Policy Committee

- Primary charge: identify barriers to faculty research and strategies to remove or overcome those barriers
- Continue ongoing work from last year

Technology-Enhanced Education Oversight Committee

- Rollout of new online learning platform
- Liaise with Education Policy Committee and others related to Aluse by students, for teaching, in classrooms, etc.

Faculty Salaries & Resources Committee

- Access, query CUPA data
- Push for market analysis and adjustment
- Continue work for last year
