# The **Carnegie** Foundation's **Classification** for Community Engagement



An **elective classification**, meaning that it is based on voluntary participation by institutions. ... It is an institutional **classification** 

It is not an award, rather a process of self-assessment and documentation of *community engagement* practice.

# Community Engagement Defined By Carnegie

Community engagement describes the <u>collaboration</u> between institutions of higher education and their larger for the <u>mutually</u> <u>beneficial exchange of knowledge and resources</u> in a context of <u>partnership</u> and <u>reciprocity.</u>

The purpose of community engagement is to <u>enrich scholarship</u>, <u>research</u>, and creative activity; enhance curriculum, teaching and <u>learning</u>; prepare educated, engaged citizens; strengthen democratic values and civic responsibility; address critical societal issues; and contribute to the public good.

# **Motivation** for seeking Carnegie Classification

**Legitimacy:** Seeking new level of legitimacy for community engagement, an institutional core priority, in a public/visible way

<u>Accountability</u>: To demonstrate accountability in fulfilling mission of serving the public good

<u>Catalyst for Change</u>: A tool for fostering institutional alignment for community-based teaching, learning, scholarship




