THE GRADUATE PROGRAM IN BIOMEDICAL SCIENCES

The Graduate Program in Biomedical Sciences (GPiBS) is a first-year, interdisciplinary program serving seven degree programs at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center (OUHSC). Students will graduate with a PhD from one of the participating programs to prepare them for careers in biomedical sciences. OU Health Sciences Center is one of only a few comprehensive academic health centers in the nation. Our internationally prominent faculty, state-of-the-art facilities, cutting-edge technology, and nearly \$200 million in external funding combine to make us the leader in graduate education and research in Oklahoma.

THE CURRICULUM

All students complete interdisciplinary coursework emphasizing the core concepts for the participating programs. During year 1, students will participate in up to six 6-week lab rotations with faculty mentors of their choice and select a specific program for their dissertation research. Students will then focus on their research, complete advanced classes relevant to their areas of specialization, and participate in journal clubs and seminars.

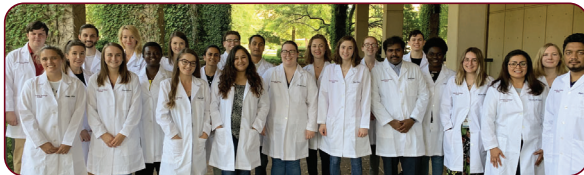
GPiBS STUDENT OUTCOMES

GPiBS students typically complete their PhD within 5.5 years, while publishing an average of 5.32 papers with their mentors. Graduates have earned post-doctoral fellowships at premier universities and competitive positions at biotechnology/pharmaceutical companies and government agencies.
