Summer Undergraduate Research Programs

The **Graduate College** at the **University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center (OUHSC)** hosts a cadre of summer programs aimed at encouraging undergraduate students to pursue careers in biomedical research and healthcare professions. These programs offer outstanding students intensive, hands-on research opportunities in the laboratories of a select group of biomedical faculty mentors. We believe that introducing undergraduate students to rigorous laboratory research experiences will promote their entry into biomedical research careers and will encourage them to consider OUHSC for their graduate education. We consist of four programs in total.

SURE: Summer Undergraduate Research Experience Program

NARCH: Native American Research Center for Health Student Development Program

OK-INBRE: IDeA Network of Biomedical Research Excellence Summer Research Program

CURE: Cancer Undergraduate Research Experience

The individual programs each have separate funding sources and emphasize different but overlapping career goals for student populations from diverse backgrounds. All build on a common platform of a biomedical research experiences. Each program offers a stipend of \$5,000 and will start **May 23rd** and conclude **July 26th** in Oklahoma City, OK.
