John Goins is currently a full time lecturer in the Department of History and Philosophy at the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley. He received his Ph.D. in 20th Century U.S. politics and society from the University of Houston in 2014. His dissertation entitled, “Confronting Itself: The AIDS Crisis and the LGBT Community in Houston,” examines the history of AIDS and the political organization of LGBT communities in Houston, Texas and the South, concurrently considering Texas politics and the influence of right wing conservatism during the 1980s. He received his MA in Postwar U.S. History from the University of Houston Clear Lake in 2007 and his BBA in Finance from Baylor University.
