

APPENDIX C – CHALKING

1. Subject to the rules in this Appendix C and to the general rules in Sections C.3 and C.4 of ADM 02-300 Speech, Expression and Assembly, UTRGV will permit chalking of sidewalks by UTRGV-affiliated individuals or organizations. Members of the public are not permitted to chalk sidewalks.
2. Chalking shall be limited to sidewalks. Chalking is not permitted:
 - a. in areas inaccessible to rain, such as the inside or outside walls of university buildings, vertical portions of stairs, columns, under covered walkways and other similar areas; and
 - b. within 20 feet of any doorway.
3. Each individual chalked message/artwork can be no larger than 5' x 5'.
4. There must be at least 20 feet between each message/artwork chalked by the same UTRGV-affiliated individual or organization.
5. The only material that may be used to mark on the sidewalks is water-soluble chalk. The following materials shall not be allowed on sidewalks:
 - a. Oil-based chalk;
 - b. Paint (including water-based, oil-based, and acrylics);
 - c. Hairspray or lacquer (sometimes used as a fixative); or
 - d. Any other permanent material.
6. The chalked message/artwork must be printed or otherwise identify the member of the UTRGV community or organization(s) sponsoring it.
7. The individual(s) or organization(s) responsible for a chalked message/artwork are responsible for removing the chalking when it falls into disrepair. The individual(s) or organization(s) can request that Facilities Planning and Operations remove the chalking for a charge.
