

Person of Interest (POI) – An individual who is not an employee or a student, is formally designated by a UTRGV employee to be granted a temporary affiliation to the university in order to support institutional activities for a short term or limited purpose. The individual is not compensated for the activities through a fee-for-services agreement or otherwise paid directly by UTRGV.

1. **POI ROTC** – An individual engaged in teaching, instructing, or other training through the Department of Military Science's ROTC program in support of preparing students for officer responsibilities in active-duty Army, Army Reserves, or Army National Guard.
2. **POI Volunteer** – An individual who is approved as a university guest according to ADM 04-208, Volunteer Service.
3. **POI Vendor/Contractor** (already created) – An individual who requires access to UTRGV campus facilities or university systems based on a contract between their employer and UTRGV.
4. **POI Collaborator** – An individual who collaborates with a PI/Grant for the purpose of supporting institutional academic research and or clinical research.
5. **POI Visiting Scholar** – An individual who is designated solely by the International Office and requires a temporary account to access university systems and limited campus facilities in support of scholarly activities, typically under the mentorship of a UTRGV faculty member.
6. **POI Community Faculty** – A non-full-time, often volunteer physician or professional designated solely by the Division of Health Affairs (HA) for the purpose of contributing to institution's academic and/or clinical enterprise will not have access to patient records or visit UT Health RGV clinical facilities.
7. **POI Clinical Community Faculty** - A non-full-time, often volunteer physician or professional designated solely by the Division of Health Affairs (HA) for the purpose of contributing to institution's academic and/or clinical enterprise through education, research (human health; patient care), and/or clinical services, pursuant to an academic affiliation agreement and/ or a clinical services agreement and an active Memorandum of Appointment (MOA). These POIs have access to UTRGV patient information and/or visit UT Health RGV clinical facilities.

8. **POI Instructor** – An individual in the Professional Education & Workforce Development Office serving as a specialized training instructor who delivers high-quality, industry-aligned training to professionals.
9. **POI Guest** – An individual who does not fall within any other POI title or category and requires temporary UTRGV access for up to 4 weeks annually.
