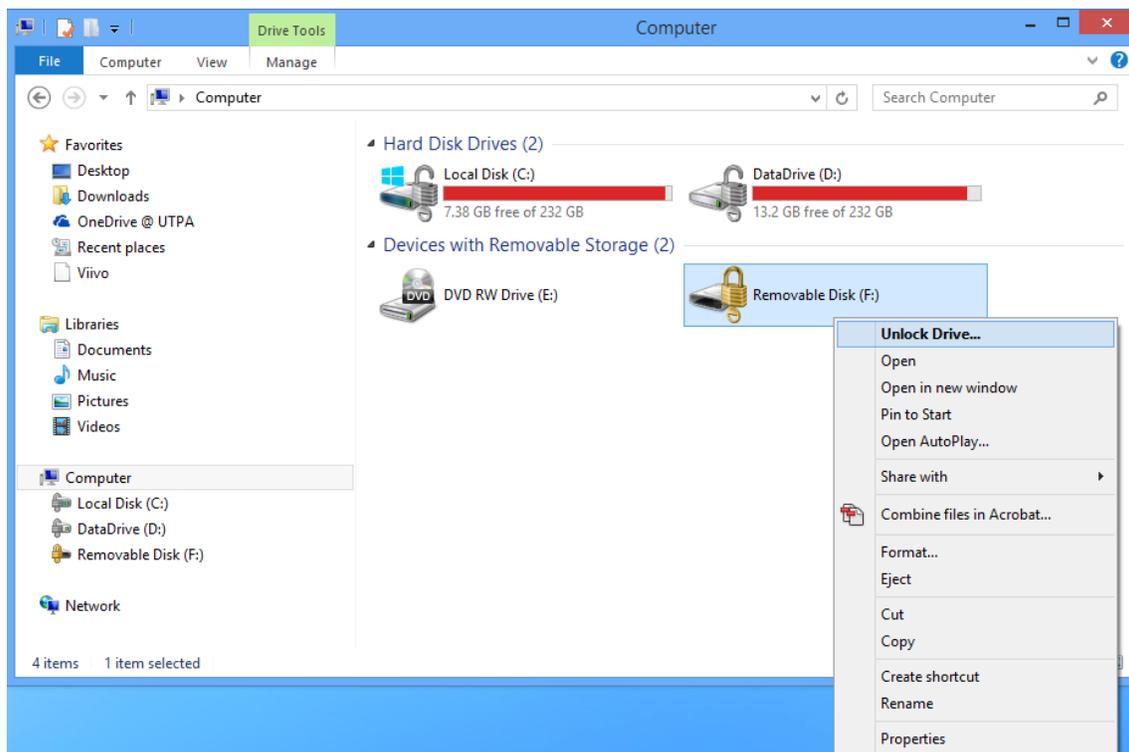


Changing a BitLocker Password

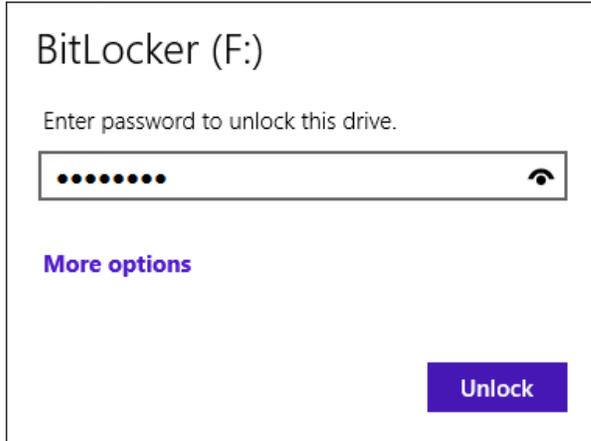
1. Connect the storage device to the computer.
2. Open the “Computer” folder.



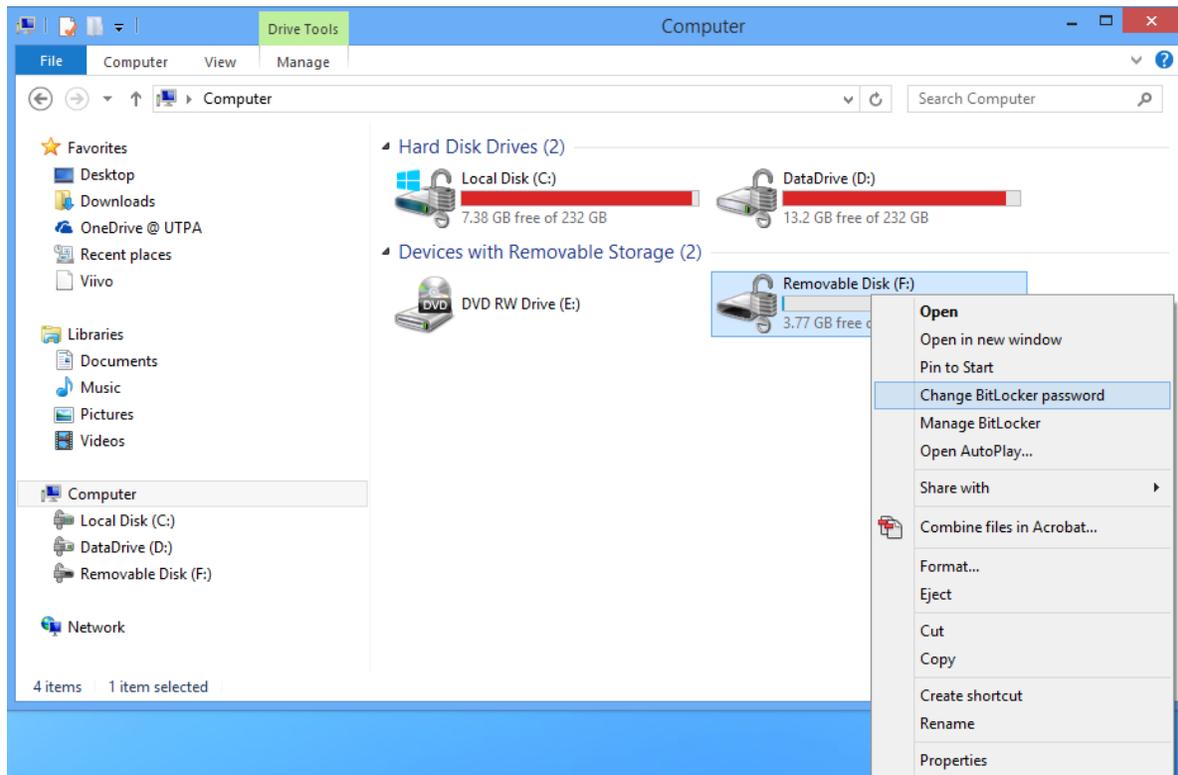
3. Right-Click on the storage device and select the “Unlock Drive...” option.



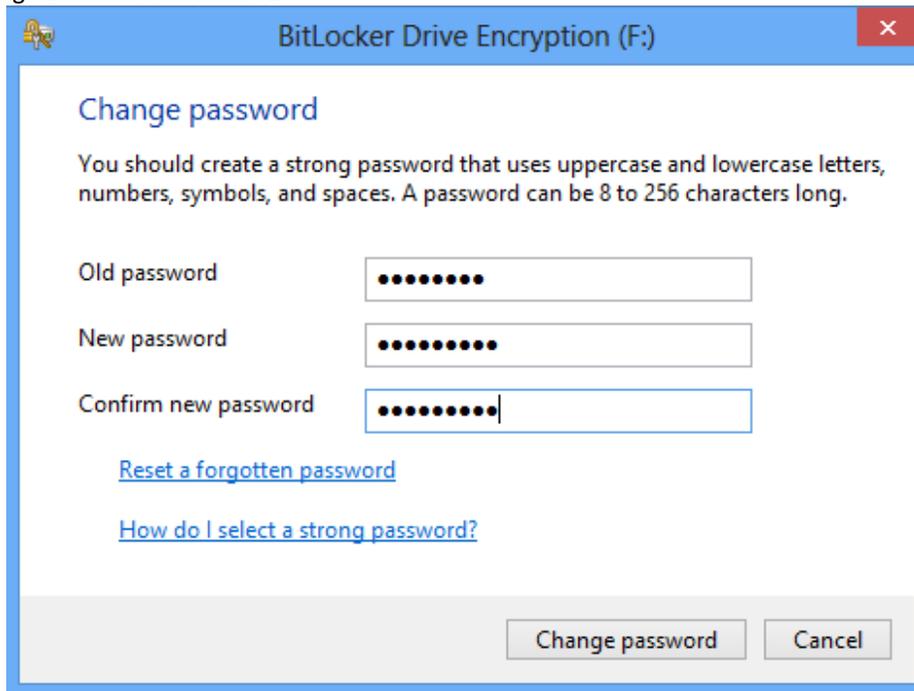
4. Enter the current password to unlock the drive.



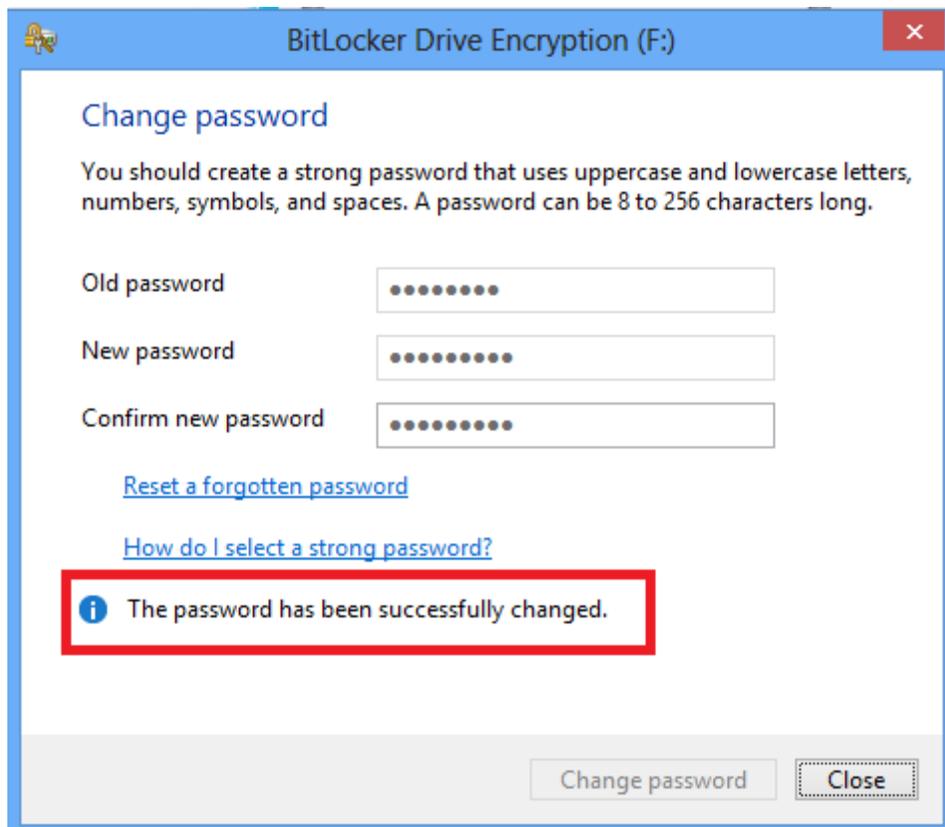
5. Once the device is unlocked, right click on the storage device again and choose "Change BitLocker password".



6. You will be prompted to again enter the current password in the "Old password" field. Then you can type in the new password in the "New password" field and then confirm it by typing the new password again in the "Confirm new password" field. Click on the "Change password" button.



7. Once your password is changed, the dialogue window will change and acknowledge that the password was changed successfully.



8. Click on the "Close" button to close the dialogue window. The new password will be used to unlock the drive from now on.

NOTE: If you forget your current or new password or have problems with your BitLocker secured storage device, you can contact the Information Security Office (956.665.7823) for assistance. Storage devices that are managed by the Information Security Office can be unlocked using the stored recovery key.
