Courses	Every exchange student must register for a minimum of 3 courses during their eschange program. Each graduate program has a different number of modules and a unique start date, so it is important to coordinate with the International Office. Students may combine courses from the same school and from different programs. If a course description is required, please contact the internationalization coordinators.	
Language requirements	At our university, most courses are taught in Spanish, requiring proof of a B2 level in the language. Some courses and programs are offered 100% in English, for which a B2 level in English is required. Please check with the international office for information on courses available in this language.	











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Nomination application deadlines	Nomination is <b>ongoing throughout the entire year</b> since graduate programs do not have specific start dates. However, we recommend coordinating with the International Office at least <b>4 months in advance</b> to ensure availability and proper planning.	
Health insurance	Every exchange student must purchase international health and accident insurance in their home country before arriving in Bolivia.	
Finding accommodation	The university does not have its own accommodation for exchange students. However, the international office can provide guidance in the rental process through its contacts. If you are unable to secure accommodation before your arrival, we recommend staying at a reasonably priced hotel for the first few days. Once here, finding housing options is relatively easy.	
Visa information	All international students need a student visa. Please contact the Bolivian Embassy or Consulate in your home country or country of residence. If you need assistance, feel free to contact us.	
Learning agreement	The Learning Agreement guarantees the recognition of academic achievements obtained during the mobility period by UPB upon the student's return.  To draft the Learning Agreement, the student should consult the course catalog. Admission to the courses selected in the Learning Agreement before mobility is not guaranteed. Final registration in the courses will only be possible after completing the enrollment process at the host university. The Learning Agreement can be adjusted once the student has completed their enrollment and selected courses at UPB.  For academic guidance and to obtain the signature on the Learning Agreement, the student may contact the international coordinator, whose name is provided in the acceptance email.
