Every room has air-conditioning. Men and women’s dorms are separate. There are two kitchens that have induction cookers and dining lounges along with microwaves, toasters and large coolers/ refrigerators in Global Village.</p>

They can bring their own from home or buy a medical plan from a Korean company upon their arrival at SCH.</p> <p>*Korean National Health Insurance is mandatory for long term residents and this will be effective from student’s alien registration. (If the student has insurance from their home country that provides the same level of coverage as Korea's National Health Insurance, they may apply for an exemption from enrolling in the National Health Insurance.)</p> <p>*Korean National Health Insurance – 72,000 KRW/month</p>	
<p>Health Clearance Requirements</p>	<p>Tuberculosis Clearance To live in the dorms, a tuberculin skin test or chest x-ray dated <u>WITHIN 1 (ONE) MONTH of the dorm move-in date</u> is required. If positive, a chest X-ray is required. Students are required to submit the results <u>AFTER</u> THEIR ACCEPTANCE.</p>

Global Village Language Exchange Program	<p>The Global Village Language Exchange Program is available to students from partner universities in countries such as Japan and select European countries, where we maintain a balanced exchange partnership. This program focuses on language and cultural exchange within the Global Village community.</p> <p>Scholarship Benefit: - Dormitory Fee Waiver: Students will have their Global Village dormitory fees (872,000 KRW) waived for the duration of their stay.</p> <p>Program Features: - Language Exchange: Students will participate in 1:1 language exchanges with Korean students for 5 to 8 hours per week. English and Japanese language exchanges are available, depending on the student's background and language preferences. - Cultural Events: While participation in cultural events is encouraged, it is not mandatory under this program. However, students are strongly encouraged to engage in these activities to maximize their cultural immersion experience. - Roommate Experience: Students will have the unique opportunity to live with a Korean roommate, further enhancing the cultural exchange experience in the Global Village dormitory.</p> <p>This program offers a focused, language-driven cultural experience, allowing students to engage with Korean peers while enjoying the benefits of the Global Village community.</p>
