

# Using Analytics

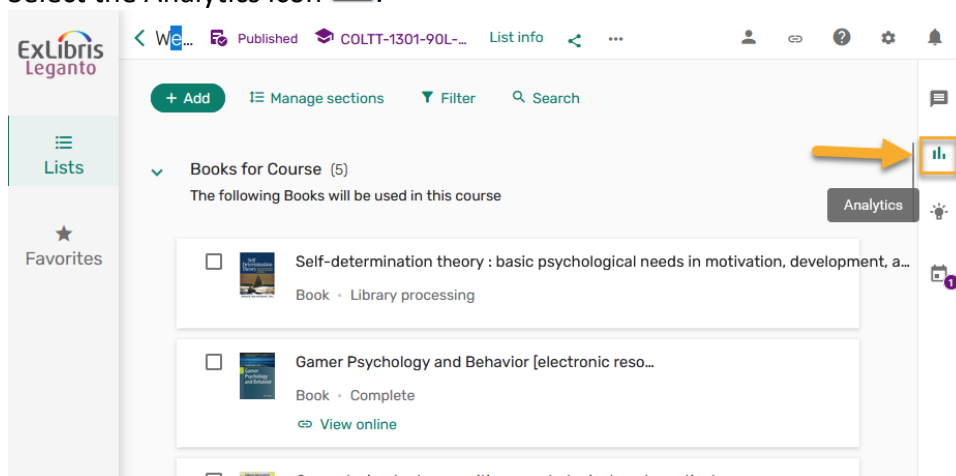
With Course Materials you can track student usage statistics which gives you a snapshot of their levels of engagement. Within a list, select the Analytics button, which appears like a bar graph, to enable Analysis Mode.

In this mode, instructors can view:

- the number of Active Students who separately interacted with each resource
- the Total Number of Activities (views) for each resource
- the overall engagement level of the resource. If students aren't using a resource, librarians can help find an alternative

To view the student usage analytics:

- Select the Analytics icon .



- From the List tab, you can view the list usage or any item usage by section. It is also possible to filter usage to a specific section or item.
