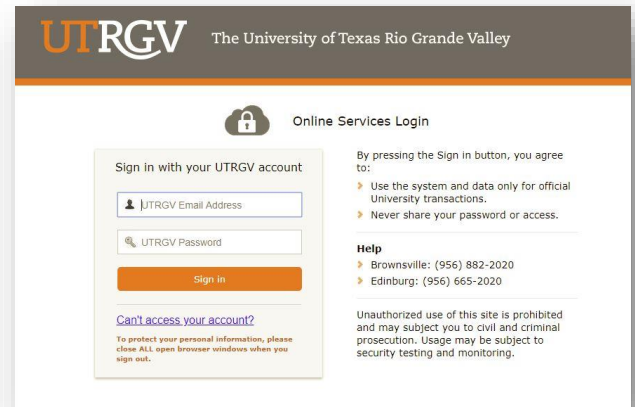
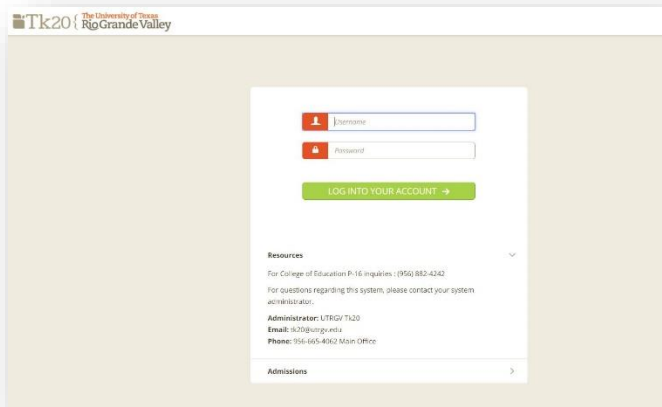

<https://utrgv.tk20.com/>

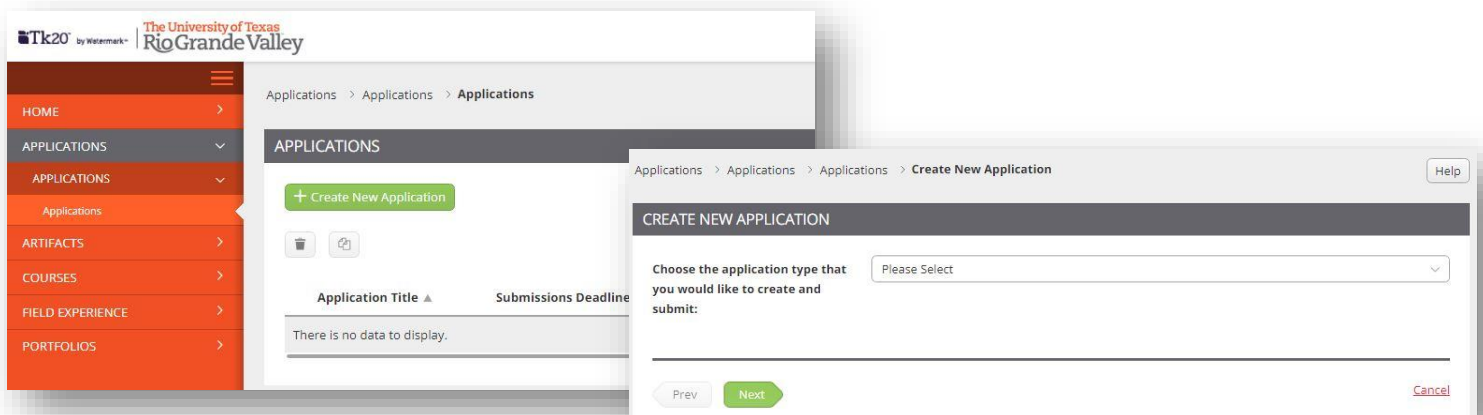
Enter your UTRGV credentials. (You will need to enter them twice in order to log into Tk20)

IMPORTANT: APPLICATION REQUIRES ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

1. Application (on file)
2. Criminal Background Check (CBC) Information
3. Resume Information for FTE/NE
4. Upload current transcripts from UTRGV or other College/Universities
5. HESI A3 Score
6. BSN Degree Plan
7. Sit (6) SCH of Non-English Proficiency (NEP)
8. Meet the BSN Program Admission Criteria as follows:
 - a. Meet UTRGV's admission requirements.
 - b. Meet academic admission each semester regarding prerequisite progression.
 - c. Meet a minimum 75% grade point average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale in all prerequisite courses.
 - d. Complete all BSN prerequisites with a minimum grade of "C" in each course.
 - e. Pass math quiz (grade of 100).
 - f. Provide proof of current certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) for health care providers (in general, American Heart Association's Heart Life Support).
 - g. Provide documentation verifying absence of active infectious pulmonary disease.
 - h. Provide documentation verifying current immunization or immunity status for specified diseases (hepatitis B, measles, mumps, rubella, tetanus/diphtheria or tetanus/diphtheria/bertussis, varicella) signed documentation by professional re: illness or immunization, flu/influenza, meningitis.
9. Submit evidence of being cleared by the state board of nursing (i.e. no criminal background check, visa must submit evidence of current licensure in state of residence).
10. Submit application to the BSN Program by March 1st, 2019.
11. Meet the HESI-A3 exam with required score.
12. Be admitted by the BSN Student Development Committee, after being rank-ordered according to prerequisite-GPA, students will be admitted on a space-available basis.

(FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ONLY)
All pre-UTexas Administrative Code, Chapter 1227.00020(a), an applicant to a university undergraduate program that leads to a bachelor's degree may satisfy the English language proficiency requirement by meeting the English language proficiency requirements of the accrediting institution of higher education (IHE) at which the applicant is enrolled, or students must take all four parts of the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) and obtain a minimum score of 20 for speaking, 22 for listening, 22 for reading, and 21 for writing.
