

PROGRAM AGREEMENT I
BETWEEN THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS AT BROWNSVILLE AND
TEXAS SOUTHMOST COLLEGE AND
SOON CHUN HYANG UNIVERISTY

WHEREAS, The University of Texas at Brownsville and Texas Southmost College UTB/TSC) and Soonchunhyang University (SCH) have previously executed an Affiliation Agreement effective on July 1st, 2011; and

WHEREAS, UTB/TSC and SCH desire to implement the provisions of such Affiliation Agreement by providing students enrolled at UTB/TSC with an educational opportunity at SCH and by providing students enrolled at SCH with an educational opportunity at UTB/TSC.

NOW THEREFORE, subject to the terms, conditions, and provisions of such Affiliation Agreement, the parties agree as follows:

1.0 Term. This Agreement shall be effective from the date of its execution and terminate at the conclusion of Spring semester 2016. Either party may terminate this agreement at any time, without penalty subject to the following notice provision. Termination by on institution shall be effected by giving the other institution at least ninety (90) days advance written notice of its intention to terminate. Further, this agreement will automatically terminate upon termination of the parent Agreement of Cooperation but any students who have commenced at either university at the date of termination may complete their courses of study. Termination shall be without penalty.

2.0 Program Students and Admission.

2.1 The exchange shall be limited to the equivalent of up to 2 (two) full year students per academic year or 4 semester students from each institution during the term of the Agreement. Both institutions will review the exchange program on a regular basis for any

imbalances in the number of students exchanged and will adjust the numbers as necessary to maintain a well-balanced program.

2.2 The overall balance of incoming and outgoing students must be maintained over the period of the agreement. Each institution has the right to approve the number of students it will receive in any given year.

2.3 UTB/TSC shall notify SCH of the students nominated by UTB/TSC to participate in the Program by April 15th for Fall Semester that year and by October 15th that year for Spring semester. SCH shall notify UTB/TSC of the students nominated by SCH by October 15th that year for Spring semester and April 15th for Fall Semester that year.

2.4 . UTB/TSC and SCH shall nominate students to participate in the exchange program based on demonstrated academic achievement and completion of curricula that are prerequisites for participation in the program.

2.5 UTB/TSC and SCH will recommend students for the program who have sufficient language proficiency to participate effectively in the instruction program offered at the host university. The host university reserves the right to make final judgment on the admissibility of each student nominated for the exchange.

2.6 UTB/TSC and SCH undergraduate students who have completed at least two years of undergraduate study are eligible to participate in the program.

3.0 Course of Study. Each participating student will take courses regularly offered at the host university, with the understanding that the host institution reserves the right to exclude students from restricted enrollment programs. The exact programs of study will be determined by the student with the mutual approval of his or her supervisors or academic advisors at UTB/TSC and SCH.

4.0 Program Payments. UTB/TSC students will register for a full course load and remain registered at UTB/TSC while attending SCH and will pay UTB/TSC tuition and fees to UTB/TSC. UTB/TSC students will be exempt from all such tuition and fees at SCH. SCH

students will register for a full load and remain registered at SCH while attending UTB/TSC and will pay SCH tuition and fees to SCH. SCH students will be exempt from all such tuition and fees at UTB/TSC. Students will pay medical insurance and other fees as required by the host institution.

5.0 Students participating in the program will be subject to and must abide by all the rules and regulations of the host institution.

6.0 Lodging/Travel/Meals. SCH will provide housing for or provide information regarding locating housing for UTB/TSC students during their semester(s) of attendance. Housing costs will be paid by the student. UTB/TSC will provide housing for or provide information regarding locating housing for SCH students during the semester(s) of attendance.
